Concerns based adoption model (CBAM)



Adobe Connect is a web conferencing platform that includes a comprehensive set of tools and features for extending learning beyond the classroom and conventional training environments. It allows computer users in various locations to share events such as meetings and classes.

Adobe Connect enables educators to **deliver** synchronous, interactive tutorials and simulations using media-rich content.

It allows users to **participate in** interactive, collaborative environments from their school, home or workplace all in an online environment while they are in geographically dispersed locations.

What should I use Connect for?

You can use Adobe Connect to have meetings or facilitate classes online when you can't meet face to face. An Adobe Connect meeting allows participants to:
